Observation: Spoke about the different facets of globalization with emphasis on economic globalization raising the issue how this is affecting state sovereignty. He opined MNCs are ruling the roost diluting the idea of sovereignty. It is economic compulsions in the geo-politics which integrates the world today and this is what globalization is doing.

Ravindra interacted in Q & A slot asking whether the grand “make in India” campaign of the new government would conflict the globalization. The speaker said, agreed it may, but, the point is how many takers are there for “make in India” and the intention may be to sell this outside and not in Indian markets thereby adding the profits to Indian kitty and therefore raising the GDP. The Dean almost in an almost informal Presidential Address, rounded the session by referring about a book titled, “Twilight of Constitutionalism” and endorsed the speaker’s perspective about the dilution of conception of state sovereignty due to the globalized order of the world.

It ended with the speaker appreciating the BHS HES management and thanking them for inviting him to be the Speaker.

6. 10/4/2015- GUEST LECTURE on “Sports Law as an Emerging Field in Law”. By, Nandan Kamath and Mr. Roshan Gopalkrishnan Nandan is Principal Lawyer at LawNK, based in Bangalore, India.

His practice specialises in sports, technology and media laws, with clients ranging from international and national sports federations, to leagues, teams, sponsors and athletes.

Nandan graduated with a B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) from the National Law School of India University, B.C.L. and M.Sc. degrees from the University of Oxford (on a Rhodes Scholarship) and an LL.M. from Harvard Law School. He acts as Managing Trustee of GoSports Foundation, a non-profit that provides scholarships and support to junior Indian athletes.

Mr. Nandan Kamath and Mr. Roshan Gopalkrishnan engaged the students in discussions on what is involved in the field of sports law. Through the interactive session Mr. Kamath and Mr. Gopalkrishnan spoke about how sports law involves torts, contracts, insurance and other fields of law. They also addressed the challenges a lawyer faces working in the field of sports. A comparative analysis was carried out on how sports law has developed across several nations.

Mr. Gopalkrishnan also spoke about IPL and the legal challenges involved in planning an event like IPL. Mr. Kamath being a Rhodes Scholar informed students about the challenges of getting a Rhodes scholarship. He advised that students should consider sports law as a career option if they are interested and work towards it.
